



GODDESS RUN TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Saturday, June 2, 2018

The 7th Annual Victoria Goddess Run will be taking place on Saturday, June 2nd in your area and will cause some traffic disruption between 8:45 am and 11:00 am. Based on feedback from 2017 and 2018 construction the day of the week has been changed to Saturday and also the route to further reduce the impact on the community.

The only road that will be closed for the duration of the event is Humpback Road from Irwin to Sooke Road.

Our event schedule is:

8:45 am 10km and 5km Start
10:45 am Humpback Road reopens

The participants cross West Shore Parkway in two locations where Traffic Control Professionals will be stopping traffic to allow the participants to cross:
East of Commander Court - 8:55 am - 9:10 am
Langford Parkway Roundabout - 9:10 – 11:00 am

The rest of the course is open to traffic including Glen Lake Road as we are starting on the Bus Lane at the school and finishing on Belmont Field. Between 8:45 – 8:50, there will be one lane used for alternating traffic to accommodate the start of the race.

1,000 women will be running and walking from the race start/finish at Belmont School on Glen Lake Road. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. We hope that you will support us as we raise money for the BC Cancer Foundation.

Please come out and cheer our Goddesses on along the race route or at the finish line. We also have an Expo with many local companies, KidZone from 8:00am to noon, as well as a yoga class that you can join from 10:30am – 11:20am. All are Free so please join us.
