The 9th Annual Victoria Goddess Run will be taking place on Saturday, June 6th in your area and will cause some traffic disruption between 8:35 am and 11:00 am.

Road Closures:

Humpback Road from Irwin to Sooke Road.

Glen Lake Road from Belmont School to the Alouette Roundabout from 8:35 – 8:55 am

Glen Lake Road from Alouette towards Sooke Road from 8:45 – 9:05 am

Langford Lake Road and Langford Parkway are open to traffic to head out to Jacklin Road, east of the Roundabout at West Shore Parkway / Langford Parkway.

Our event schedule is:

8:45 am 10km and 5km Start

10:45 am Humpback Road reopens

The participants cross West Shore Parkway in two locations where Traffic Control

Professionals will be stopping traffic to allow the participants to cross:

West Shore Parkway, East of Commander Court - 8:50 am - 9:20 am

Langford Parkway Roundabout – 8:55 am – 11:00 am

The rest of the course is open to traffic including Glen Lake Road as we are starting on the Bus Lane at the school and finishing on Belmont Field. Between 8:45 – 8:50, there will be one lane used for alternating traffic to accommodate the start of the race.

1,200 women will be running and walking from the race start/finish at Belmont School on Glen Lake Road. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience this may cause. We hope that you will support us as we raise money for the BC Cancer Foundation.

Please come out and cheer our Goddesses on along the race route or at the finish line. We also have an Expo with many local companies, a Free KidZone that you can join from 9 am – 11:30 am. Please join us.
